

The main version of the logo consists of a modular simplified Tryzub symbol and monospaced letters "documenting Ukraine" in small caps.



The safe zones of the logo are built on the optical compensation of the weight of the sign.







A short version of the logo with text in variant 2 is possible only on a light (white) background in full color.








LOGO - USAGE RULES

- 4. Use the white version of the sign with dark text on complex backgrounds.


