

Finding Aid for the IWM-Archive

The IWM-Archive is the third archive at the institute. The first archive was established in the 1980s and brings together the works of Czech philosopher Jan Patočka (1907–1977). The second one was established after the passing of the institute's founder, Krzysztof Michalski (1948–2013), and contains his philosophical writings; it was opened in 2019.

The IWM-Archive serves to preserve, catalogue, and make available the documents that have been collected since its founding in 1982. It represents the institutional memory of the IWM; its holdings (with the exception of group A) are also available for research and study purposes. Structure of the IWM archive

The structure of the IWM archive follows largely the structure and chronology of the IWM from 1982 (foundation) to 2013 (passing of the founder), see the classification below. The holdings from the years 2014 onwards have also been listed but are still interim archive material and will only be released for use at a later date. Until 2013 the structure of the IWM was relatively simple: most of the Institute's activities can be assigned to research foci and projects for which the Permanent Fellows were responsible.

The chronology is based on a dense reporting system that documents practically all of the IWM's activities up to 2015:

- Reports (3 brochures: 1982 - 1985, 1986 - 1990, 1993)
- Annual programs (1993 - 2014)
- IWM Newsletter (No. 1 - 86 / 1986 - 2004)
- its successor IWMpost (No. 87 - 119 / 2005 - 2017)
- Activity reports (from 1994)
- IWM websites (1998 - 2021)

All of these sources are available upon request from the IWM-Archive.

Following the Michalski era, the annual program was discontinued in 2015 and the IWMpost was converted into a magazine in 2017; the bulletin with reports on the activities of the IWM, its fellows, and its publications was thus discontinued. The IWM website (version 2013–2020) covered the function of ongoing reporting. In fact, this version and its predecessors reflected the institute's activities from 2020 back to the 1990s in detail. They have been archived but are no longer preserved in their entirety.

The structure of the archive was created on the basis of the above-mentioned sources. It essentially covers the years 1982 to 2013 and represents the central finding aid. (Projects that were started during this period were included until their completion, even if this was after 2013.)

The research-related part of the archive (C.) is structured chronologically and sorted by research foci. In addition, there are events (D.: conferences, workshops, lecture series, lectures, public debates) and publications (E.). An important part of the archive is the correspondence. The correspondence of the founding rector has been filed chronologically and alphabetically (under A.) and is currently being catalogued. Further correspondence can be found in the respective project folders, among other places.

In addition to the folders, the IWM has documented events extensively in a photo-archive, which has been scanned and catalogued in a database, as well as an archive of audio recordings, which have also been digitized and catalogued. The corresponding digital copies can be accessed at the IWM on request. In addition, the 50 issues of the Institute's journal, *Transit – Europäische Revue*, published between 1990 and 2017, have been digitized; all articles are freely accessible on the IWM website.

The majority of the IWM-Archive in its current form consists of paper documents, which were generally filed and stored in folders at the time of their creation. These folders were not altered and assigned to a category of the structure, given a corresponding reference number, and stored in the premises of the IWM. In this way, all archival materials of this type have an individual reference number to which future research on the archive can and should refer.

Classification

Each element or group of elements of the archive materials has been assigned an alphanumeric reference code consisting of the main category (A. to I.), the numbered subcategory and, if applicable, the year. Example: D.2.2001.2 The Memory of the Century = category D (Events), subcategory 2 (Individual Events), year (2000), second folder; the reference code is usually followed by the surviving inscription on the spine of the folder. In category C (Research foci and Projects), the reference code also contains the initials of the project leads; in addition, the year indicates the year in which a project started.
